

MEETING OF GLEBE RESIDENTS.

At 8 p.m. on Thursday, April 24, a meeting will be held upstairs at Glebe Town Hall in St. John's Road.

The meeting has been organised to discuss the formation of a Glebe Society similar to the already existing groups in Paddington, Hunter's Hill and Elsworth.

It is envisaged that the proposed Glebe Society will be strictly Non-Political

Its tentative objects are to foster an interest in the history and the planned development and preservation of Glebe and to provide residents with a collective voice in event of any threat to the Glebe area (a threat similar, for example, to the Department of Main Roads for Paddington last year).

At the April 24 meeting it is proposed, if the meeting is agreeable, to set up a Glebe Society, elect a provisional committee and consider a draft constitution.

Representatives from, The National Trust, the Civic Trusts Council and from the Paddington, Hunter's Hill groups and from other bodies will be at the meeting. I hope you can come along to this meeting. If you cannot, perhaps you could come to a subsequent meeting.
